

Heat Treatment Health and Safety Precautions

There are a few things that you will want to do to reduce safety concerns; these things are explored further below:



Make sure you remove anything that is flammable or potentially explosive from the home before the heating treatment begins. This includes things like gasoline, propane canisters, and the like. If you do not, you risk an explosion and a house fire. You should also remove all pressurized items – lighters, hairspray, fire extinguishers etc.

Items that must be removed or protected:

Pets – including fish in aquariums.

House plants.

Fresh food, fruits, vegetables, etc.

Food that melts – chocolate, candy, etc.

Prescription and over the counter medications.

Make-up – especially lipstick (wax based).

Wax based items – Candles, wax figurines, wax fruit.

Anything pressurized – spray cans, fire extinguishers, oxygen bottles, etc.

Flammables lighters, lamp fuel, alcohol, solvents, etc.

Wooden and stringed musical instruments – leave the cases.

Family heirlooms and irreplaceable items should be inspected and a determination made as to whether they should be treated.
